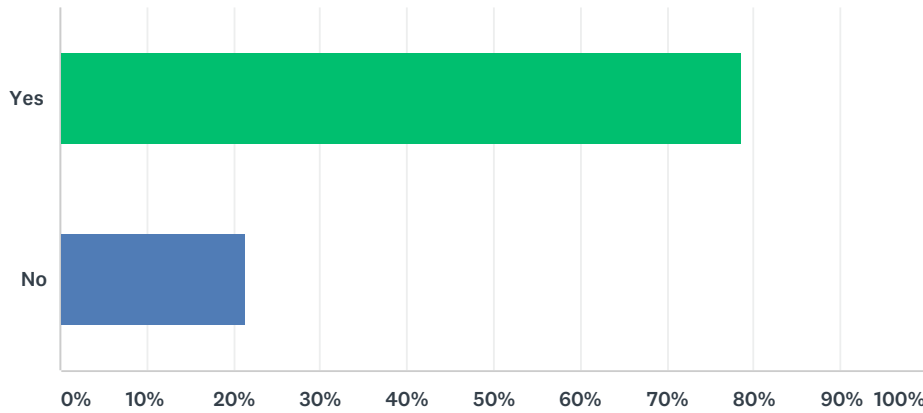

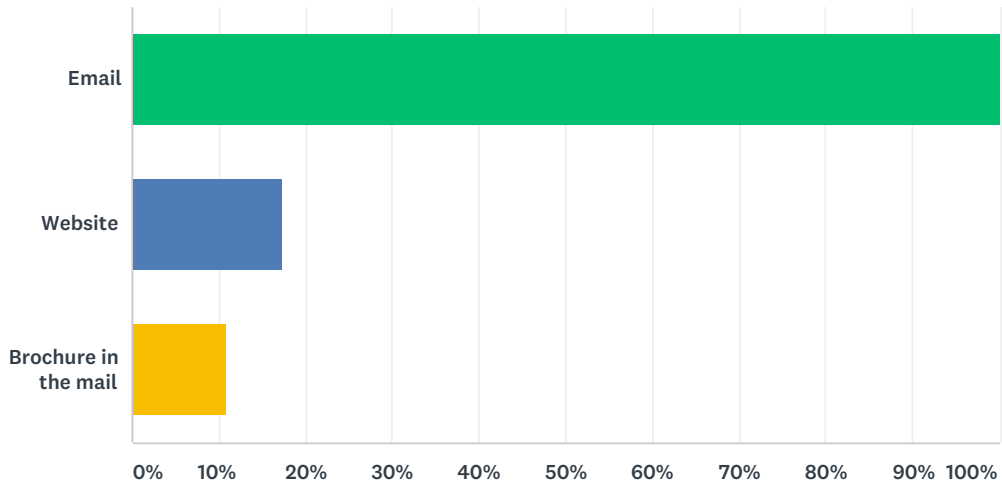

### Q3 What is your preferred communication method for learning about upcoming trainings and professional development? (check all that apply)

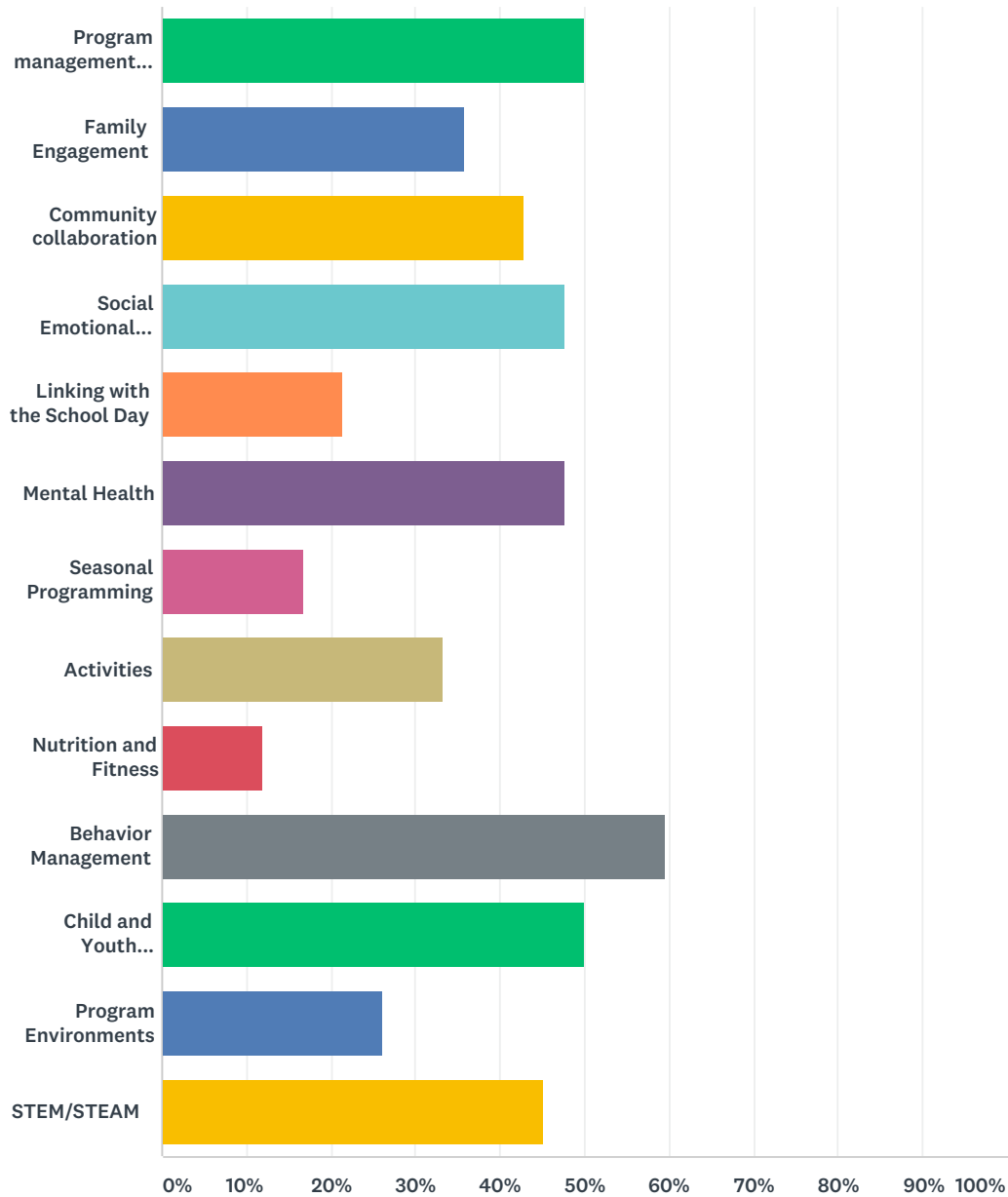

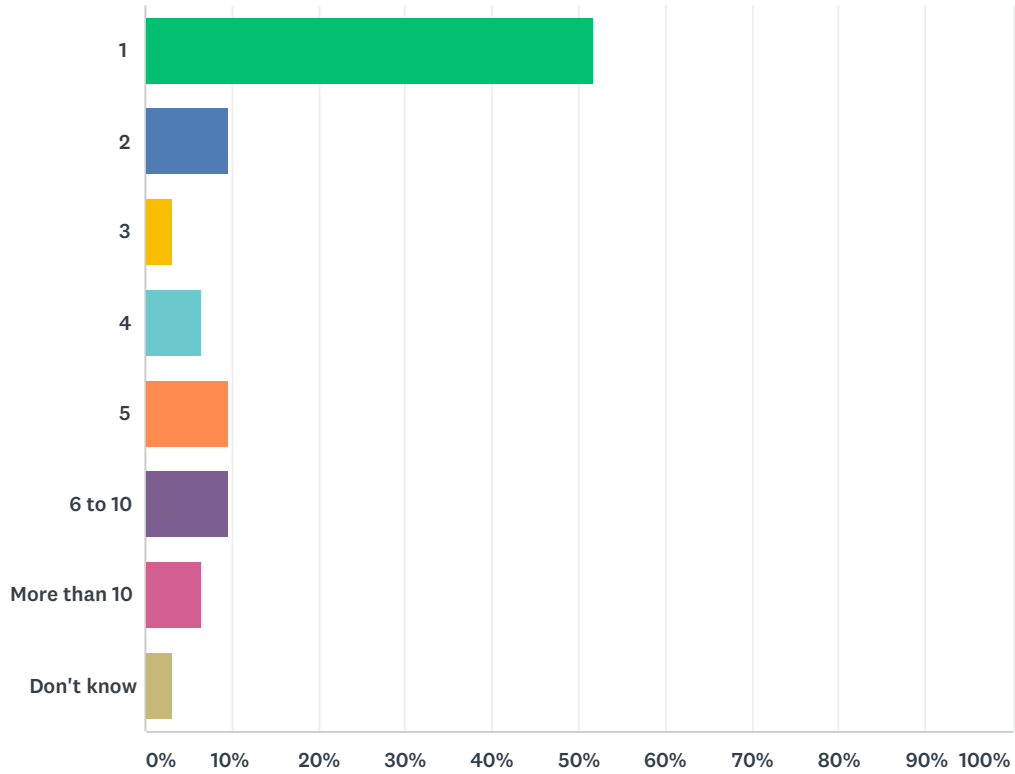

## Q10 How many sites do you operate?

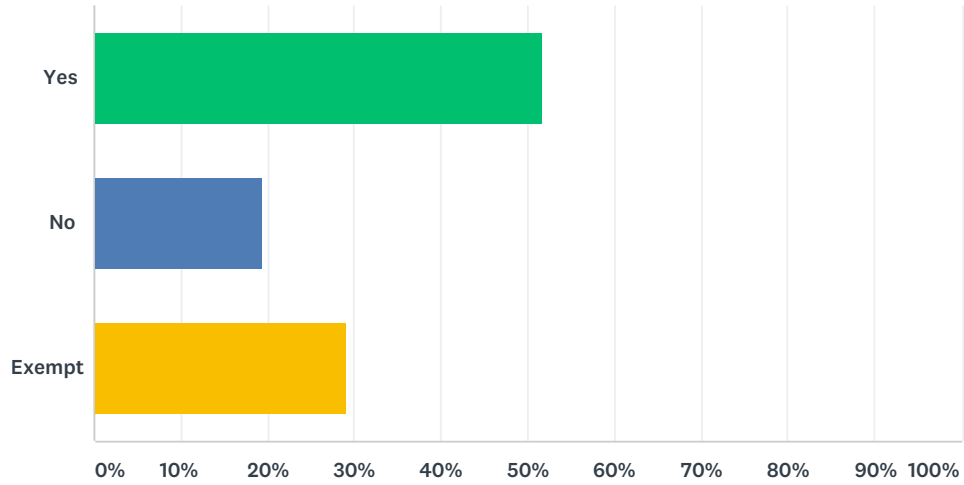

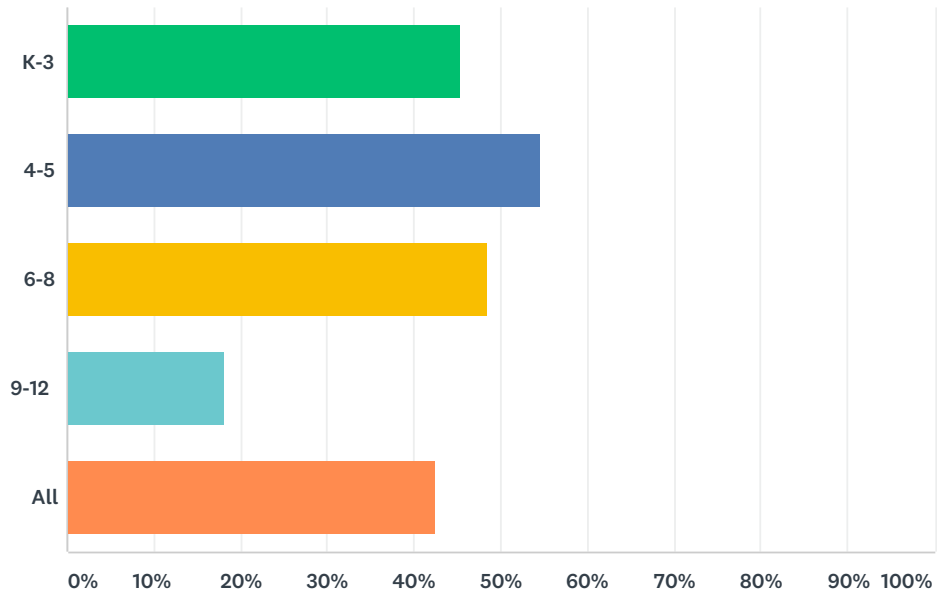
